On the occasion of the renovation of the Pyramid Laboratory-Observatory, BTicino and the Ev-K2-CNR Committee have signed a technical partnership and design agreement.

A technological and design partnership has been signed between **BTicino** and the **Ev-K2-CNR Committee for renovation of the Pyramid Laboratory-Observatory on Mount Everest.** BTicino will provide new electrical wiring and technological systems in the Research Centre facilities and the annexed staff lodge by designing systems and supplying electrical materials.

The Pyramid Laboratory-Observatory, dedicated to Prof. **Ardito Desio**, was opened in 1990 at an elevation of more than 5000 metres, at the foot of the Nepalese slope of Everest, and takes the form of a pyramid of glass, aluminium and steel.

The facility is operated by the Ev-K2-CNR Committee and the **Nepal Academy of Science and Technology.** Their partnership has given rise to 520 scientific missions with the participation of 220 researchers and 143 different international scientific institutions.

The independent lodge is made in the style of Nepalese lodge architecture and can host up to 20 researchers, technicians and logistics staff.
